## **Terms and Conditions**

### **Conditions of participation**

The Swiss Enduro Series Rule Book is accepted with the registration. The competition regulations also apply to the registration of other or additional persons (third parties). The organiser assumes that these third parties have authorised the registering person to register. If underage participants are registered by third parties, the organiser assumes that the legal representatives have given their consent.

### **Important information for your registration**

We do not accept any liability for accidents that occur during or before the 'Swiss Enduro Series' enduro mountain bike race. Accident and liability insurance is the responsibility of the participants. Registration is only possible online.

After the registration deadline two weeks before the race, registrations will only be considered for an additional CHF 20.00. Changes to the category can be reported directly to BikeMedia up to 3 weeks before the race. Changes received later will be charged at CHF 20.00. Late registrations on site are not possible.

After registration, the amount must be paid within 10 days, otherwise the registration expires. The registration is only considered confirmed when the registration has been paid. Otherwise the right to a starting place is cancelled. An administration fee of CHF 10.00 will be charged for cancellations up to three weeks before the race. Cancellations made less than three weeks before the race can no longer be considered. In the event of cancellation due to illness or accident, the above conditions also apply.

The organiser reserves the right to disqualify participants at any time and without refunding the participation fee if they have either provided false personal data when registering or if there is suspicion that they are taking part in the race after taking unauthorised substances (e.g. doping).

BikeMedia may set a participant limit. If this limit is reached, registrations received after this date can no longer be considered. Registrations will be entered in a waiting list and considered according to the time of receipt of registration.

No refunds will be made for duplicate registrations made in error.

We ask participants to take out cancellation insurance.

If the Swiss Enduro Series cannot be held or can only be partially held due to force majeure, extraordinary risks including weather risks or official orders, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee. If the event has to be organised to a limited extent due to official instructions, the entitlement to a refund for participants will lapse.

BikeMedia and the respective organiser reserve the right to postpone the race. If the race is postponed to a later date, the normal cancellation conditions apply.

All deliveries and services of BikeMedia based on online orders via the Internet or other online services are subject to these terms and conditions.

### **Data protection for registrations**

By registering, participants agree to the following points:

- The personal data provided in the registration form may be stored and processed for the purposes of organising and running the event, including by third-party companies.
- The personal data collected may be passed on to third parties for the purpose of timekeeping, creation and publication of the start and result lists.
- The organiser may publish this data in all relevant media (homepage, print media, Internet and TV).
- The photos and film recordings made in connection with our event may be used without remuneration and published on TV, the Internet, in advertising material, magazines and books.
- Companies commissioned by BikeMedia shall take pictures at the event, which may be used by the organiser, BikeMedia and the commissioned third party.
